

## COMMISSIONER MEETING

THE EXECUTIVE SESSION OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS WAS HELD AT 8:00 A.M. PRESENT WERE COMMISSIONER PHILLIP MARSHALL, COMMISSIONER TODD EWEN, COMMISSIONER RICK ROBERTS, ATTORNEY APRIL GELTMAKER, AND AUDITOR KYRA STEPHENSON. THE UNDERSIGNED CERTIFY THAT THE ONLY ITEMS DISCUSSED WERE I.C. 5-14-1.5-6.1(b)(2)(B) INITIATION OF LITIGATION OR LITIGATION THAT IS EITHER PENDING OR HAS BEEN THREATENED SPECIFICALLY IN WRITING.

THE MEETING WAS OPENED WITH THE PLEDGE TO THE FLAG BY COMMISSIONER ROBERTS FOLLOWED BY A PRAYER LED BY COMMISSIONER EWEN.

COMMISSIONER EWEN MADE A MOTION TO APPROVE THE CLAIMS, PAYROLL, AND MINUTES. THE MOTION WAS SECONDED BY COMMISSIONER ROBERTS. MOTION PASSED.

**MAINSTREAM FIBER**

REPRESENTATIVES FROM MAINSTREAM ATTENDED A PRIOR MEETING INQUIRING ABOUT GIVING THEM ACCESS FOR FIBER LINES TO BE RAN TO THE UNDERSERVED AREAS OF THE COUNTY. THEY ARE REQUESTING THE CONSIDERATION OF AN INFRASTRUCTURE DEVELOPMENT ZONE AND WOULD LIKE AN ABATEMENT. THE AREA THEY ARE LOOKING TO SERVE WOULD BE THE WEST AND SOUTHWEST AREA OF THE COUNTY. THE COMMISSIONERS SUGGESTED THEY TALK WITH THE COUNCIL ABOUT THE ABATEMENTS. PREVIOUSLY, THE OTHER FIBER COMPANIES IN THE AREA HAVE RECEIVED 10-YEAR ABATEMENTS AND THE COMMISSIONERS FELT SURE THE COUNCIL WOULD WANT TO TREAT THEM THE SAME AS THE OTHERS. THEY WILL SET UP A DATE AND TIME TO MEET WITH THE COUNCIL.

**ON-SIGHT SEWAGE ORDINANCE**

THE COMMISSIONERS HAD THEIR FIRST READING OF THE ON-SIGHT SEWAGE ORDINANCE AT THEIR LAST MEETING ON NOVEMBER 19, 2024. WITH THE PUBLIC HAVING NO QUESTIONS OR CONCERNS COMMISSIONER EWEN MADE A MOTION TO APPROVE THE ON-SIGHT SEWAGE ORDINANCE AS WRITTEN. MOTION WAS SECONDED BY COMMISSIONER ROBERTS. MOTION PASSED.

**ORDINANCE AMENDING THE PERSONNEL POLICY – DEPUTY AMBULANCE DIRECTOR EXEMPT**

THE EMPLOYEE PERSONNEL HANDBOOK DID NOT SPECIFY HOW THE DEPUTY AMBULANCE DIRECTOR SHOULD BE ACCRUING TIME. AFTER SOME DISCUSSION AND TALKING WITH WAGGONER, IRWIN, AND SCHEELE IT WAS DECIDED TO MAKE THE DEPUTY AMBULANCE DIRECTOR EXEMPT WITH BENEFITS. THIS IS THE FIRST READING OF THE ORDINANCE AND THE COMMISSIONERS WILL VOTE ON THIS AT THEIR NEXT MEETING ON DECEMBER 17, 2024.

**HIGHWAY DEPARTMENT**


