STRUCTURE POINT SUBMITTED THEIR AGREEMENT TO THE AUDITOR'S OFFICE FOR APPROVAL. COUNTY ATTORNEY APRIL GELTMAKER REVIEWED THE AGREEMENT AND HAD SOME CHANGES SHE FELT WAS NEEDED IN THE CONTRACT. THE AUDITOR'S OFFICE HAS SENT THE AGREEMENT BACK AND ONCE THE CHANGES HAVE BEEN MADE THE COMMISSIONER'S CAN APPROVE THE AGREEMENT IN A MEETING.

HOOSIER PLANNING WILL BE WORKING WITH THE PLAN COMMISSION TO DISCUSS THEIR PLANS. THEY WILL ALSO SUBMIT AN AGREEMENT FOR THE COMMISSIONERS TO APPROVE.


THERE WAS DISCUSSION ON TRYING TO DO A PLACER TECHNOLOGY STUDY. THIS STUDY TRACKS THE NUMBER OF VEHICLES COMING THROUGH THE COUNTY AND WHERE THEIR POINTS OF INTEREST ARE TO GET A BETTER UNDERSTANDING OF WHAT INDIVIDUALS ARE COMING TO WASHINGTON COUNTY FOR. SOME OF THE POINTS OF ATTRACTION ARE THE SPEEDWAY, DRAG STRIP, BECKS MILL, AND OTHER NUMEROUS FESTIVITIES THAT HAPPEN THROUGHOUT THE COUNTY. THEY WOULD LIKE THE AREA SCHOOLS TO ALSO PARTICIPATE IN THE PLANNING AND ASK THEM ABOUT COURSES THAT DO MORE TO GIVE KIDS THE KNOWLEDGE OF LIFE SKILLS THAT AREN'T BE TAUGHT NOW.
