THE EXECUTIVE SESSION OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS WAS HELD AT 8:00 A.M. PRESENT WERE COMMISSIONER PHILLIP MARSHALL, COMMISSIONER TODD EWEN, COMMISSIONER RICK ROBERTS, ATTORNEY APRIL GELTMAKER, AND AUDITOR KYRA STEPHENSON. THE UNDERSIGNED CERTIFY THAT THE ONLY ITEMS DISCUSSED WERE I.C. 5-14-1.5-6.1(b)(2)(B) INITIATION OF LITIGATION OR LITIGATION THAT IS EITHER PENDING OR HAS BEEN THREATENED SPECIFICALLY IN WRITING.

THE MEETING WAS OPENED WITH THE PLEDGE TO THE FLAG BY COMMISSIONER ROBERTS FOLLOWED BY A PRAYER LED BY COMMISSIONER EWEN.

COMMISSIONER ROBERTS MADE A MOTION TO APPROVE THE CLAIMS, PAYROLL, AND MINUTES. THE MOTION WAS SECONDED BY COMMISSIONER EWEN. MOTION PASSED.

ORDINANCE AMENDING THE PERSONNEL POLICY TO ADD EXEMPT POSITION

THE ORDINANCE AMENDING THE PERSONNEL POLICY TO INCLUDE THE DEPUTY AMBULANCE DIRECTOR AS AN EXEMPT EMPLOYEE WAS READ AGAIN. WITH THERE BEING NO QUESTIONS OR CONCERNS COMMISSIONER ROBERTS MADE A MOTION TO APPROVE THE ORDINANCE. MOTION WAS SECONDED BY COMMISSIONER EWEN. MOTION PASSED.

RESOLUTION OBLIGATING ARP FUNDS

A RESOLUTION OBLIGATING THE ARP FUNDS WAS READ BY ATTORNEY GELTMAKER. THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF TREASURY ISSUED RULES AND TIMELINES FOR THE OBLIGATION AND EXPENDITURE OF THE ARP FUNDS INCLUDING A DEADLINE OF DECEMBER 31, 2024 FOR ALL FUNDS TO BE OBLIGATED. FUNDS NOT SPENT OR OBLIGATED WOULD HAVE TO BE RETURNED TO THE TREASURY. THE COUNTY WOULD LIKE TO OBLIGATE THE REMAINING FUNDS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$621,910.20 TO THE WASHINGTON COUNTY HIGHWAY DEPARTMENT PROJECT. COMMISSIONER MARSHALL MADE A MOTION TO APPROVE THE RESOLUTION OBLIGATING THE ARP FUNDS FOR THE WASHINGTON COUNTY HIGHWAY DEPARTMENT PROJECT. MOTION WAS SECONDED BY COMMISSIONER ROBERTS. MOTION PASSED.

HIGHWAY DEPARTMENT

BIDS FOR BRIDGE 61 ON BATA ROAD WERE READ ALLOWED. TEMPLE AND TEMPLE WAS THE ONLY BID IN THE AMOUNT OF \$585,542.00. COMMISSIONER ROBERTS MADE A MOTION TO ACCEPT THE BID FOR REVIEW. MOTION WAS SECONDED BY COMMISSIONER EWEN. MOTION PASSED.

SUPERINTENDENT VOYLES PROVIDED A FINANCIAL COMMITMENT LETTER FOR COMMUNITY CROSSINGS TO THE SIGNED BY THE COMMISSIONERS.


WASHINGTON COUNTY ECONOMIC GROWTH


WASHINGTON COUNTY TOURISM


BIS AGREEMENT
