THE MEETING WAS OPENED WITH THE PLEDGE TO THE FLAG BY COMMISSIONER ROBERTS FOLLOWED BY A PRAYER LED BY COMMISSIONER EWEN.

**COMMUNITY CROSSINGS PAVING BID OPENING**

LIBS PAVING - \$2,272,451.00

**HOOSIER HILL PACT**

HOOSIER HILLS PACT FISCAL MANAGEMENT WILL BE CHANGING OVER TO RBR ALLIANCE. THE COUNTY CURRENTLY HAS A LEASE AGREEMENT FOR THE WOMENS SHELTER THAT WILL NEED TO BE REDONE. RBR ALLIANCE WILL BE TAKING OVER ON JULY 1, 2024 AT WHICH TIME A NEW LEASE FOR THE WOMENS SHELTER WILL NEED TO BE APPROVED.

**RESOLUTION AND INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT – DISPATCH**

ATTORNEY GELTMAKER PRESENTED A RESOLUTION AND INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE COUNTY AND THE CITY OF SALEM. THE INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT STATES THE COUNTY WILL TAKE OVER DISPATCH FOR THE CITY OF SALEM AND WILL PAY THE COUNTY \$130,000.00 A YEAR FOR TWO EMPLOYEES. THE AGREEMENT IS FOR FIVE YEARS AT WHICH TIME IT WILL AUTOMATICALLY RENEW UNLESS EITHER PARTY DECIDES TO TERMINATE THE AGREEMENT. COMMISSIONER EWEN MADE TO MOTION TO ACCEPT THE INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT AND RESOLUTION. MOTION WAS SECONDED BY COMMISSIONER ROBERTS. MOTION PASSED.

**HIGHWAY DEPARTMENT**


