THE EXECUTIVE SESSION OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS WAS HELD AT 8:00 A.M. PRESENT WERE COMMISSIONER PHILLIP MARSHALL, COMMISSIONER TODD EWEN, COMMISSIONER RICK ROBERTS, ATTORNEY APRIL GELTMAKER, AND AUDITOR KYRA STEPHENSON. THE UNDERSIGNED CERTIFY THAT THE ONLY ITEMS DISCUSSED WERE I.C. 5-14-1.5-6.1(b)(2)(B) INITIATION OF LITIGATION OR LITIGATION THAT IS EITHER PENDING OR HAS BEEN THREATENED SPECIFICALLY IN WRITING, I.C. 5-14-1.5-6.1-(9)

THE MEETING WAS OPENED WITH THE PLEDGE TO THE FLAG BY COMMISSIONER ROBERTS FOLLOWED BY A PRAYER LED BY COMMISSIONER EWEN.

COMMISSIONER EWEN MADE A MOTION TO APPROVE THE CLAIMS, PAYROLL, AND MINUTES. THE MOTION WAS SECONDED BY COMMISSIONER ROBERTS. MOTION PASSED.

GIS MAPPING AGREEMENT – CORELOGIC

HARRISON COUNTY RIVERBOAT INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT

HARRISON COUNTY REQUESTED APPROVAL OF THE INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT FOR THE RIVERBOAT SHARES. THIS IS A YEARLY AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE COUNTIES. COMMISSIONER EWEN MADE A MOTION TO ACCEPT THE RIVERBOAT INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT. MOTION WAS SECONDED BY COMMISSIONER ROBERTS. MOTION PASSED.

HIGHWAY DEPARTMENT

THE HIGHWAY DEPARTMENT HAS BEEN WORKING ON INSTALLING NEW CULVERTS WITHIN THE COUNTY. THE SALT BIN HAS BEEN FILLED AND TWO HUNDRED TONS OF SALT HAVE BEEN ORDERED FOR NEXT YEAR THROUGH THE STATE.

THE COMPLETE BRIDGE DESIGN HAS BEEN SENT FOR BRIDGE 118. THE COMPLETE DESIGN SHOULD BE DONE BY JUNE 1, 2024 AND WILL TAKE BIDS FOR REPLACING THE BRIDGE AFTER THE FINAL COMPLETION.

BRIDGE 39 WILL BE THE NEXT BRIDGE TO BE REPLACED. IT IS AN OLD IRON BRIDGE AROUND FRANKLIN BOTTOMS ROAD. THERE IS A LARGE LOG JAM UP FROM THE BRIDGE AND WILL WORK WITH THE LAND OWNERS TO GAIN ACCESS TO THE JAM IN ORDER TO CLEAR IT OUT BEFORE REPLACING THE BRIDGE. THEY WILL WORK ON GETTING THE BRIDGE SURVEYED AND THE TOPO MAPPING DONE.

FAIRGROUNDS

THERE ARE SEVERAL TREES AT THE FAIRGROUNDS THAT NEED TO BE LOOKED AT FOR LARGE FALLING LIMBS. THE COMMISSIONERS WILL GET ESTIMATES ON TREE REMOVAL OR TRIMMING.
