THE EXECUTIVE SESSION OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS WAS HELD AT 8:00 A.M. PRESENT WERE COMMISSIONER PHILLIP MARSHALL, COMMISSIONER TODD EWEN, COMMISSIONER RICK ROBERTS, ATTORNEY APRIL GELTMAKER, AND AUDITOR KYRA STEPHENSON. THE UNDERSIGNED CERTIFY THAT THE ONLY ITEMS DISCUSSED WERE I.C. 5-14-1.5-6.1(b)(2)(B) INITIATION OF LITIGATION OR LITIGATION THAT IS EITHER PENDING OR HAS BEEN THREATENED SPECIIFICALLY IN WRITING.

THE MEETING WAS OPENED WITH THE PLEDGE TO THE FLAG BY COMMISSIONER ROBERTS FOLLOWED BY A PRAYER LED BY COMMISSIONER EWEN.

COMMISSIONER ROBERTS MADE A MOTION TO APPROVE THE CLAIMS, PAYROLL, AND MINUTES. THE MOTION WAS SECONDED BY COMMISSIONER EWEN. MOTION PASSED.

HEALTH BOARD APPOINTMENTS

THE HEALTH BOARD RECOMMENDED REAPPOINTING DR JEFFERY MORGAN AS THE HEALTH OFFICER. COMMISSIONER EWEN MADE A MOTION TO REAPPOINT DR JEFFERY MORGAN AS THE HEALTH OFFICER. MOTION WAS SECONDED BY COMMISSIONER ROBERTS. MOTION PASSED.

ON-SITE SEWAGE SYSTEMS ORDINANCE

CHRIS BOLING WITH THE HEALTH BOARD PRESENTED THE ON-SITE SEWAGE SYSTEMS ORDINANCE FOR THE COMMISSIONERS APPROVAL. THE PURPOSE OF THIS ORDINANCE IS TO PROVIDE MINIMUM STANDARDS FOR THE PREVENTION AND SUPPRESSION OF DISEASE AND HEALTH RISKS ASSOCIATED WITH THE USE OF ON-SITE SEWAGE SYSTEMS. THE ORDINANCE WILL REGULATE LOCATION, INSTALLATION, CONSTRUCTION, MAINTENANCE, RECONNECTION, REPLACEMENT, ALTERATION, AND REPAIR OF ALL RESIDENTIAL AND COMMERCIAL SEWAGE SYTEMS. THE ORDINANCE HAS BEEN PASSED BY THE HEALTH BOARD. ATTORNEY GELTMAKER SUGGESTED THE COMMISSIONERS TABLE A DECISION UNTIL THEY HAVE HAD TIME TO REVIEW THE ORDINANCE.

WASHINGTON COUNTY VETERANS MEMORIAL BRIDGE DEDICATION


COURTHOUSE RE-APPRAISAL

MALCON

THE FEE FOR THE COST ALLOCATION IS \$10,500.00 FOR 2024-2026. COMMISSIONER EWEN MADE A MOTION TO ACCEPT THE COST ALLOCATION PLAN FROM MALCON. MOTION WAS SECONDED BY COMMISSIONER ROBERTS.
