THE EXECUTIVE SESSION OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS WAS HELD AT 8:00 A.M. PRESENT WERE COMMISSIONER PHILLIP MARSHALL, COMMISSIONER TODD EWEN, COMMISSIONER TONY CARDWELL, ATTORNEY STEVE LANGDON, AND AUDITOR KYRA STEPHENSON. THE UNDERSIGNED CERTIFY THAT THE ONLY ITEMS DISCUSSED WERE I.C. 5-14-1.5-6.1(b)(2)(D) DISCUSSION OF STRATEGY WITH RESPECT TO A REAL PROPERTY TRANSACTION, I.C. 5-14-1.5-6.1(b)(19) TO HAVE COMMUNICATIONS WITH AN ATTORNEY THAT ARE SUBJECT TO THE ATTORNEY CLIENT PRIVILEGE, I.C. 5-14-1.5-6.1(b)(2)(B) INITIATION OF LITIGATION OR LITIGATION THAT IS EITHER PENDING OR HAS BEEN THREATENED SPECIFICALLY IN WRITING.

COMMISSIONER MARSHALL ASKED FOR A MOTION TO APPROVE THE AGENDA AS PRESENTED. COMMISSIONER EWEN MADE A MOTION THAT THE AGENDA BE AMENDED TO MOVE THE LADY MUSKETEERS STATE BASKETBALL CHAMPS BEFORE PUBLIC COMMENT. MOTION WAS SECONDED BY CARDWELL. MOTION PASSED.

**ITEMS FOR CONSIDERATION**

• **APPROVAL OF MEETING MINUTES FROM APRIL 7, 2026**

COMMISSIONER MARSHALL CALLED FOR A MOTION TO APPROVE THE MINUTES. COMMISSIONER EWEN MADE A MOTION TO APPROVE THE MINUTES AS PRESENTED. MOTION WAS SECONDED BY COMMISSIONER MARSHALL. ATTORNEY LANGDON QUESTIONED

CARDWELL ON HIS REASONING FOR NOT APPROVING THE MINUTES. CARDWELLS RESPONSE WAS THAT IT ISN'T AN ACCURATE ACCOUNT OF THE MEETING. ATTORNEY LANGDON ASKED HIM SPECIFICALLY WHAT NEEDED CHANGED AND HE COULD NOT COME UP WITH A SPECIFIC RESPONSE. MOTION PASSED 2-1 WITH CARDWELL OPPOSING.

- **APPROVAL OF CLAIMS AND PAYROLL**

COMMISSIONER EWEN MADE A MOTION TO APPROVE THE CLAIMS AND PAYROLL. MOTION WAS SECONDED BY CARDWELL. MOTION PASSED.

- **RBR ALLIANCE/BLUE RIVER SERVICES SOUTHERN INDIANA TRANSIT SERVICES**

RBR ALLIANCE PRESENTED AN AUTHORIZING RESOLUTION FOR THEM TO APPLY FOR GRANTS FOR THE SOUTHERN INDIANA TRANSIT SERVICES. COMMISSIONER MARSHALL MADE A MOTION TO APPROVE THE RESOLUTION FOR GRANT FUNDING. MOTION WAS SECONDED BY COMMISSIONER EWEN. MOTION PASSED.

- **CITY OF SALEM – PETITION TO CANCEL PROPERTY TAXES, DELINQUENCIES, FEES, INTEREST AND PENALTIES – 103 W HOMER STREET**

THE CITY OF SALEM IS REQUESTING TAXES AND PENALTIES BE REMOVED FROM TAX ROLE ON A PIECE OF PROPERTY DEEMED AS AN “UNSAFE PREMISES”. THE CITY OF PLANNING ON BIDDING ON THE PROPERTY AT THE SHERIFF SALE AT 10:00 A.M. CARDWELL DID NOT WANT TO MOVE FORWARD WITH REMOVING THE TAXES AND PENALTIES UNTIL THE CITY HAD A DEED IN HAND. ATTORNEY MARK CLARK AND MAYOR JUSTIN GREEN WILL RETURN WITH THE DEED AFTER THE SHERIFFS SALE.

- **HIGHWAY DEPARTMENT**

THE HIGHWAY DEPARTMENT HAS BEEN SPRAYING POISON HEMLOCK, PATCHING POTHOLES, AND GETTING THE MOWERS READY. THEY HAVE ALSO BEEN DOING RIP RAP REPAIR WORK AT THE SPARKSVILLE CROSSING .

- **BOARD COMMENTS AND CONCERNS**

CARDWELL ASKED ABOUT THE SIGN ORDINANCE THAT WAS READ AT THE LAST MEETING. COMMISSIONER EWEN HAD SOME LANGUAGE HE WOULD LIKE TO SEE CHANGED AND WILL TALK WITH ATTORNEY GELTMAKER ABOUT THOSE CHANGES.

CARDWELL ASKED FOR AN UPDATE ON THE HIGHWAY PROJECT. A WALK THROUGH HAS BEEN DONE WITH THE CITY AND CORRECTIONS HAVE BEEN MADE. HINDERLITER HAS REACHED OUT TO SEE WHEN FUEL WILL BE ADDED TO THE TANKS SO THEY CAN COME AND DO THEIR START UP WORK.

COMMISSIONERS RECESSED UNTIL ATTORNEY CLARK AND MAYOR GREEN CAME BACK WITH A DEED.
