THE EXECUTIVE SESSION OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS WAS HELD AT 8:00 A.M. PRESENT WERE COMMISSIONER PHILLIP MARSHALL, COMMISSIONER TODD EWEN, COMMISSIONER TONY CARDWELL, ATTORNEY APRIL GELTMAKER, AND AUDITOR KYRA STEPHENSON. THE UNDERSIGNED CERTIFY THAT THE ONLY ITEMS DISCUSSED WERE I.C. 5-14-1.5-6.1(b)(2)(B) INITIATION OF LITIGATION OR LITIGATION THAT IS EITHER PENDING OR HAS BEEN THREATENED SPECIFICALLY IN WRITING.

- **HIGHWAY DEPARTMENT PROJECT UPDATE**  
THE MASONRY WORK HAS STARTED AND WILL CONTINUE ON THE OFFICE BUILDING WEATHER PERMITTING. WORKING ON GETTING SOME PLUMBING ADJUSTMENTS MADE ON THE MECHANICS GARAGE. THE MIXED SALT BUILDING WALLS ARE UP AND WILL BE POURING THE SLAB WHICH WILL BE 80 X 100. GRABERS WILL BE GETTING STARTED ON THE SALT BUILDING. THE FOOTINGS AND WALLS ARE ALMOST DONE FOR THE AGGREGATE BINS. THE WALLS WILL BE 12". THE SEPTIC FIELD WILL BE INSTALLED IN JULY AND THE STORM SEWER WILL BE ESTABLISHED AND RAN. TEMPLES WAS TO MEET WITH GRABERS TO REVIEW AND GO OVER DETAILS FOR THE REMAINING BUILDINGS.
