THE EXECUTIVE SESSION OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS WAS HELD AT 8:00 A.M. PRESENT WERE COMMISSIONER PHILLIP MARSHALL, COMMISSIONER TODD EWEN, COMMISSIONER TONY CARDWELL, ATTORNEY APRIL GELTMAKER, AND AUDITOR KYRA STEPHENSON. THE UNDERSIGNED CERTIFY THAT THE ONLY ITEMS DISCUSSED WERE I.C. 5-14-1.5-6.1(b)(9) TO DISCUSS EMPLOYMENT MATTER OF INDIVIDUAL EMPLOYEES, I.C. 5-14-1.5-6.1(b)(2)(B) INITIATION OF LITIGATION OR LITIGATION THAT IS EITHER PENDING OR HAS BEEN THREATENED SPECIFICALLY IN WRITING.

THE REGULAR MEETING OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS WAS HELD AT 9:00 A.M. THE MEETING WAS CALLED TO ORDER BY COMMISSIONER MARSHALL. THOSE IN ATTENDANCE WERE COMMISSIONER MARSHALL, COMMISSIONER EWEN, COMMISSIONER CARDWELL, ATTORNEY APRIL GELTMAKER, AUDITOR KYRA STEPHENSON.

CARDWELL LED THE PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE. PRESTON SHELL GAVE THE PRAYER.

COMMISSIONER MARSHALL ASKED FOR A MOTION TO APPROVE THE AGENDA AS PRESENTED. COMMISSIONER EWEN REQUESTED THE 2026 HOLIDAY SCHEDULE BE ADDED TO THE AGENDA FOR APPROVAL. COMMISSIONER EWEN MADE A MOTION TO APPROVE THE AGENDA WITH THE 2026 HOLIDAY SCHEDULE ADDED. MOTION WAS SECONDED BY CARDWELL. MOTION PASSED.

ITEMS FOR CONSIDERATION

- **APPROVAL OF MEETING MINUTES FROM NOVEMBER 4, 2025**
COMMISSIONER EWEN MADE A MOTION TO APPROVE THE MINUTES FROM THE NOVEMBER 4, 2025 MEETING. CARDWELL COMPLAINED THERE WAS NOT ENOUGH INFORMATION FROM THE END OF THE LAST MEETING. ATTORNEY GELTMAKER AGAIN REITERATED THERE ARE NO REQUIREMENTS ON HOW THE MINUTES HAVE TO BE DONE AND IF SOMETHING NEEDS TO BE CHANGED, A RESPONSE BACK TO THE AUDITOR NEEDS TO BE DONE. COMMISSIONER MARSHALL ASKED CARDWELL WHAT HE WANTED ADDED AND HE SAID HE DIDN'T KNOW. COMMISSIONER MARSHALL SECONDED THE MOTION. MOTION PASSED WITH CARDWELL OPPOSING.
- **APPROVAL OF CLAIMS AND PAYROLL**
COMMISSIONER EWEN MADE A MOTION TO APPROVE CLAIMS AND PAYROLL. MOTION WAS SECONDED BY CARDWELL. MOTION PASSED.
- **OPIOID APPLICATION – MYRA ALBERTSON AND JOE KELTNER**
THE JRAC BOARD ASKED THE COMMISSIONERS TO ALLOW RELEASING FUNDS FOR PROJECT LIFE SAVER. THEY RECEIVED A REQUEST FOR \$2,000.00 TO PURCHASE BRACELETS FOR INTELLECTUALLY DISABLED, ELDERLY, OR OTHER INDIVIDUALS THAT MIGHT NEED TO BE MONITORED FOR THEIR WHEREABOUTS. THESE BRACELETS HAVE A TRACKING DEVICE IN THEM AND ALLOWS THEM TO BE LOCATED SHOULD THEY GO MISSING. PROJECT LIFE SAVER CURRENTLY HAS 7 BRACELETS AND THEY WOULD LIKE TO PURCHASE MORE. COMMISSIONER EWEN MADE A MOTION TO ALLOW THE RELEASE OF FUNDS FOR THE REQUEST FROM PROJECT LIFE SAVER. MOTION WAS SECONDED BY CARDWELL. MOTION PASSED.
- **HEALTH BOARD APPOINTMENT**
MAGGIE ENGLAND NOTIFIED THE COMMISSIONER'S THAT DR HEDRICK WILL BE STEPPING OFF OF THE HEALTH BOARD. SHE HAS SPOKEN WITH DR JARED KEARSCHNER AND HE IS INTERESTED IN FILLING THE VACANCY. COMMISSIONER MARSHALL MADE A MOTION TO APPOINT JARED KEARSCHNER TO THE HEALTH BOARD. MOTION WAS SECONDED BY CARDWELL. MOTION PASSED.
